Karnataka Gazetteer Department Annual Report for the Year 2022-23

The Karnataka Gazetteer Department was established in 1958 with the objective of publishing the District/Taluk Gazetteers in order to revise the District Gazetteers published in the pre-independence period and consolidate the progress achieved in various fields since independence. Initially, the Central Gazetteer Unit set out some guidelines with a view to expanding development and advancement facilities in addition to general content. Accordingly, as per the policy of the Central Government, the District Gazetteers of the 20 Districts which existed till 1990 had been published in English. The Karnataka Gazetteer Department has since started publishing the revised editions of the District Gazetteer in Kannada and has so far published in all 10 districts of Kodagu, Dharwad, Kalaburagi, Vijayapura, Mandya, Kolar, Dakshin Kannada, Udupi, Chamarajanagar and Tumkur districts. Kodagu, Dharwad, Gulbarga, Bijapur, Mandya, Kolar, Dakshina Kannada, and Udupi District Gazetteers have been published under the program to translate District Gazetteers from Kannada to English. In 2019 Bidar district gazetteer (English) has been published.
