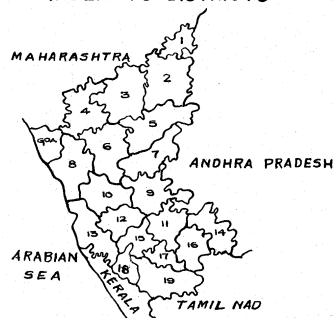

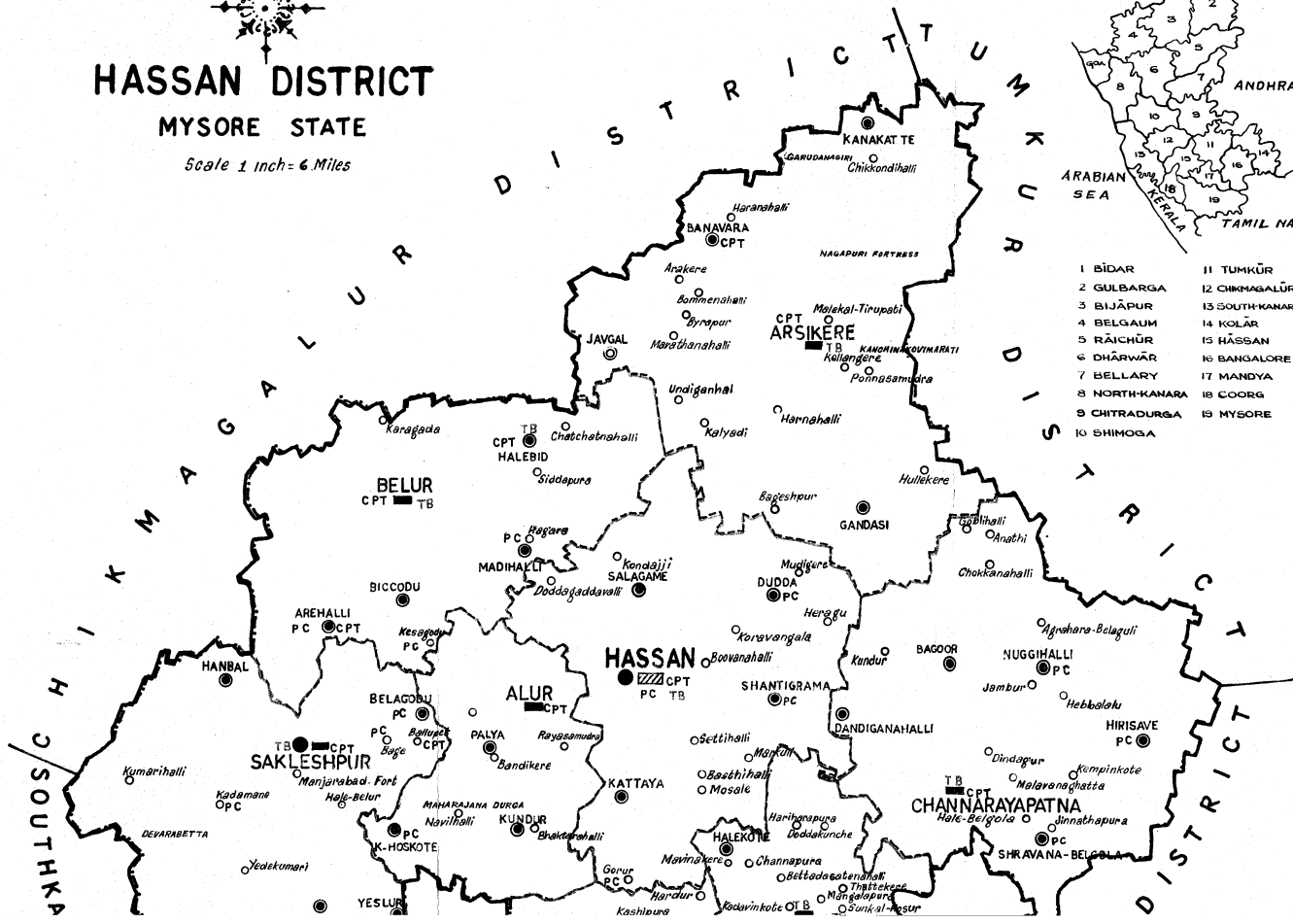
HASSAN DISTRICT MYSORE STATE

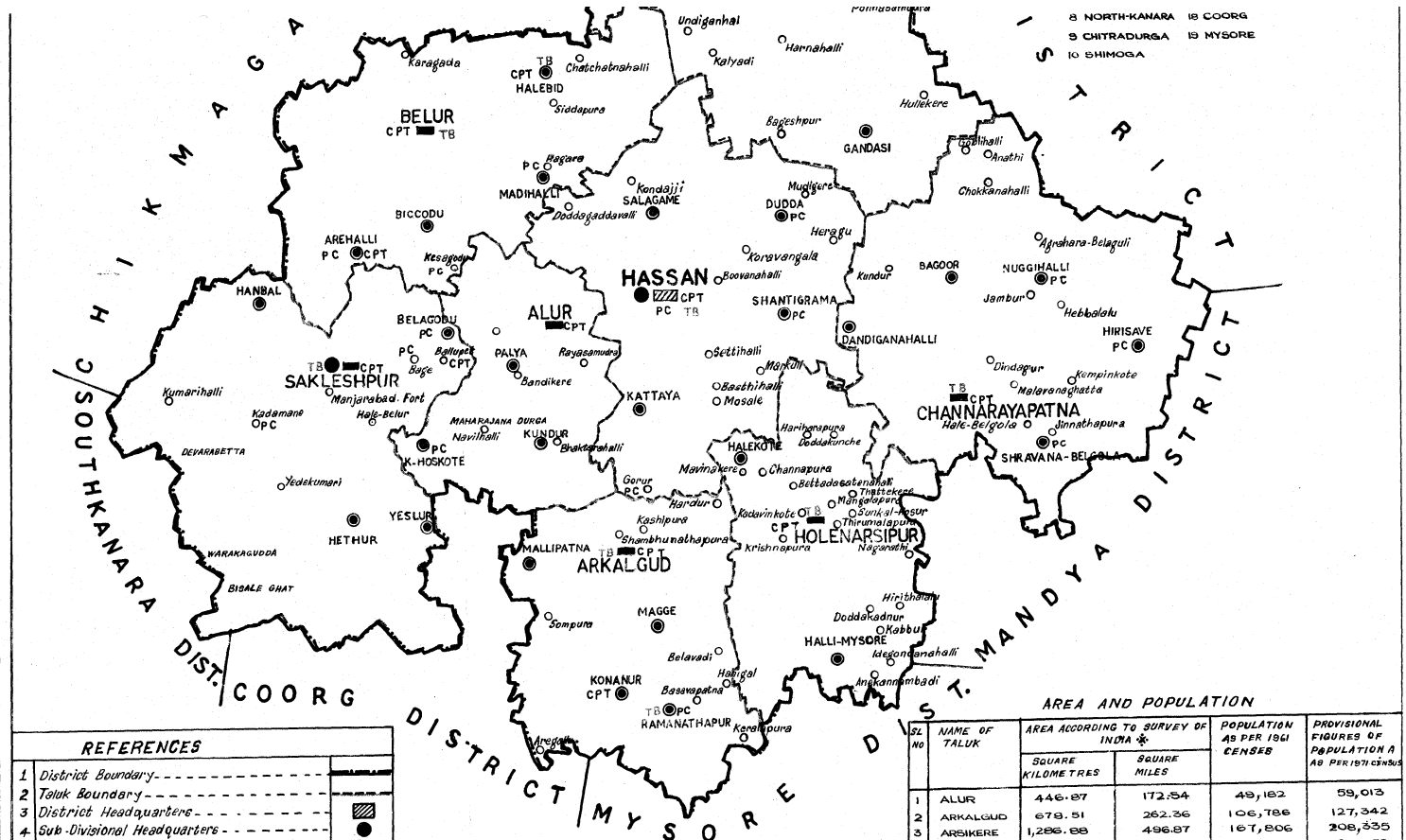
