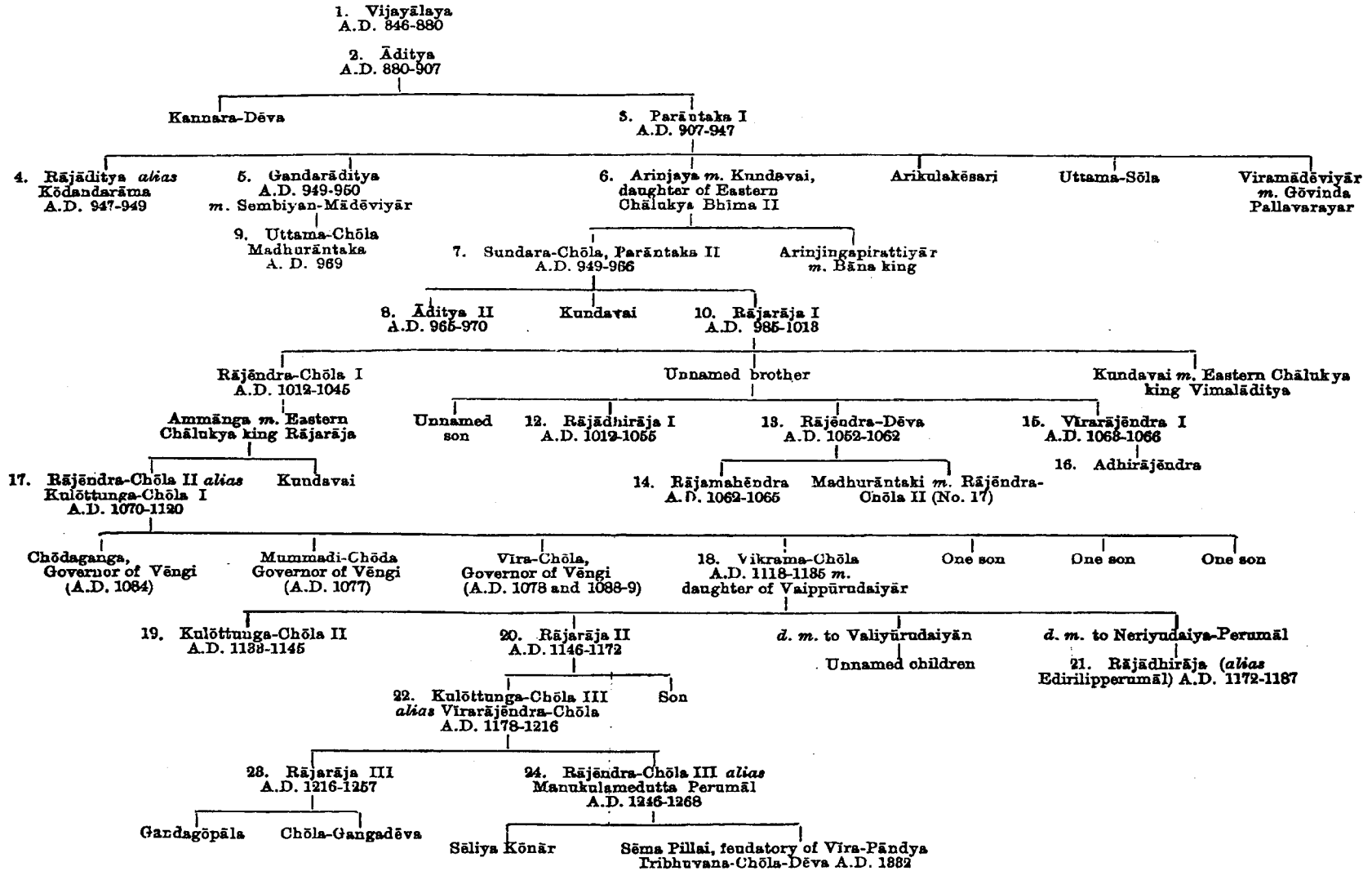


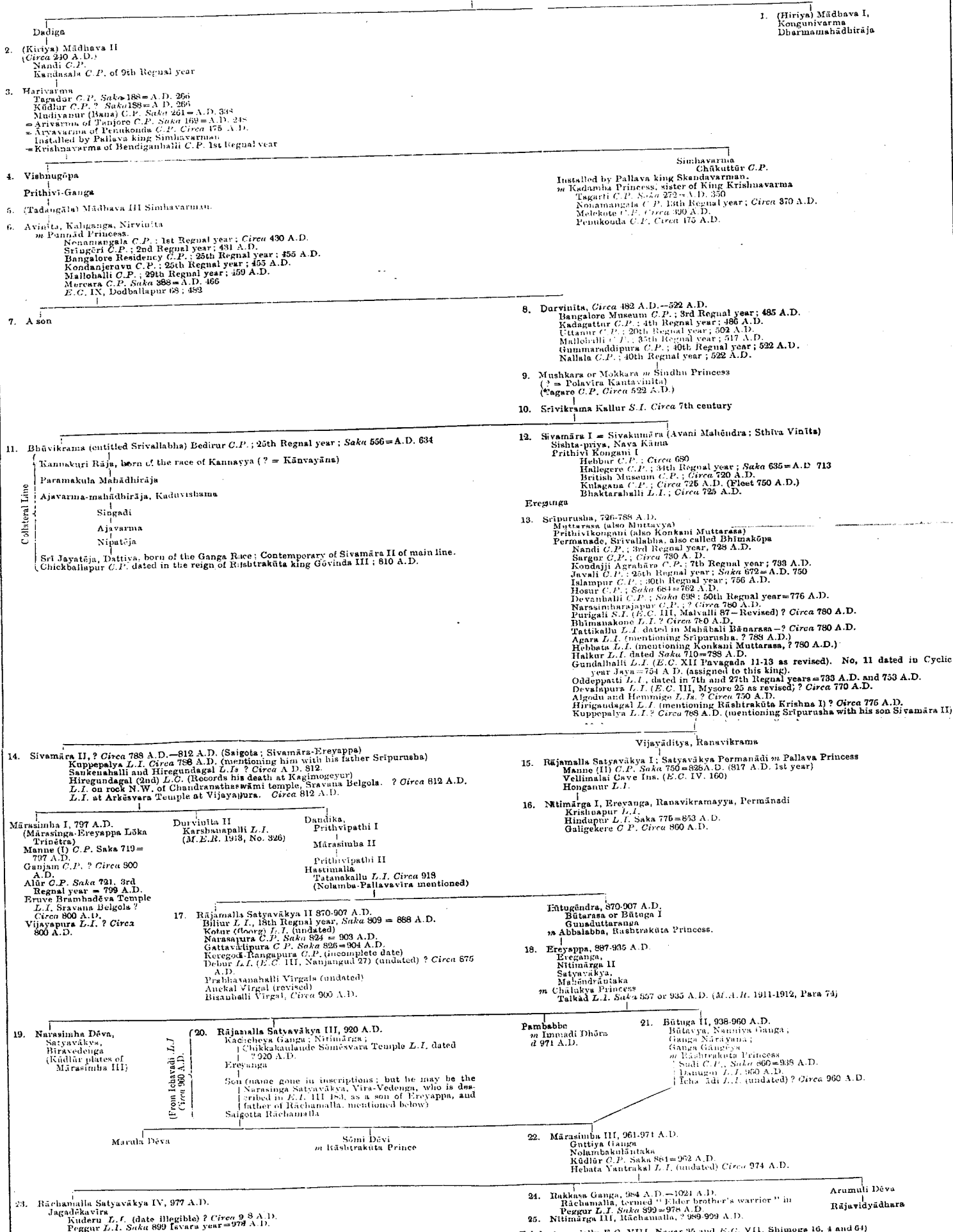
# GENEALOGY OF THE IMPERIAL CHOLA DYNASTY—A.D. 846—A.D. 1332.

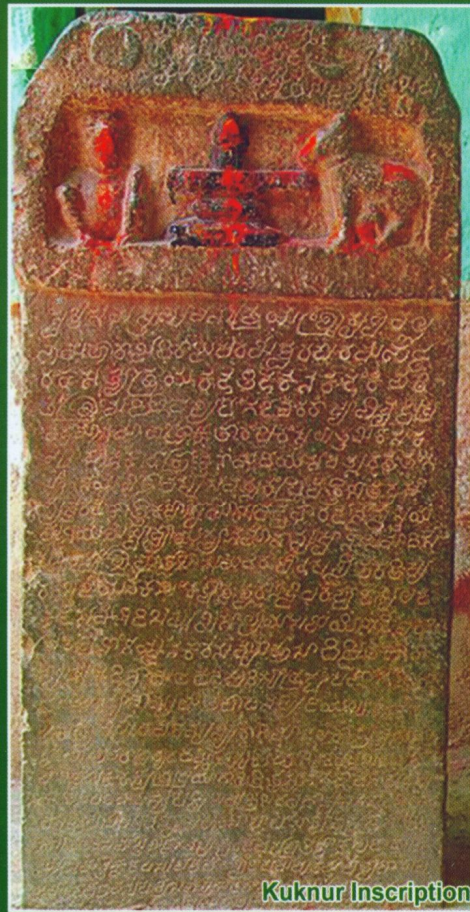

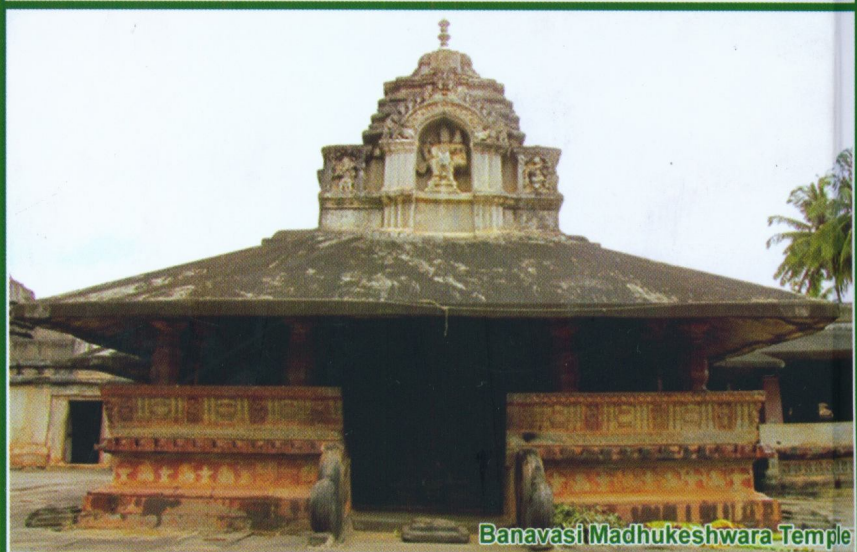
A daughter *m. Mahā-Pradhāna Aliya Māchaya*  
Dandanāyaka, *Aliya* because he was son-in-law of Ballāla III



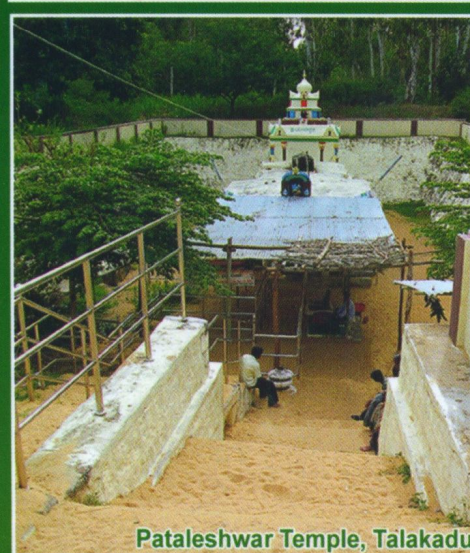
